Traditional Pronouns:

He	<i>He</i> laughed.	I called <i>him</i> .	<i>His</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>his</i> .	He likes <i>himself</i> .
She	<i>She</i> laughed.	I called <i>her</i> .	<i>Her</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>hers</i> .	She likes <i>herself</i> .
They	<i>They</i> laughed.	I called <i>them</i> .	<i>Their</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>theirs</i> .	They like <i>themselves</i> .
No pronoun	<i>Jo</i> laughed.	I called <i>Jo</i> .	<i>Jo's</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>Jo's</i> .	Jo likes <i>Jo</i> .
One	<i>One</i> laughed.	I called <i>one</i> .	<i>One's</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>one's</i> .	One likes <i>oneself</i> .
It	<i>It</i> laughed.	I called <i>it</i> .	<i>Its</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>its</i> .	It likes <i>itself</i> .

Invented Pronouns:

Spivak	<i>Ey</i> laughed.	I called <i>em</i> .	<i>Eir</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>eirs</i> .	<i>Ey</i> likes <i>eirself</i> .
Elverson	<i>Ey</i> laughed.	I called <i>em</i> .	<i>Eir</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>eirs</i> .	<i>E</i> likes <i>emself</i> .
Ze and hir	<i>Ze</i> laughed.	I called <i>hir</i> .	<i>Hir</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>hirs</i> .	<i>Ze</i> likes <i>hirsself</i> .
Ze and zir	<i>Ze</i> laughed.	I called <i>zir</i> .	<i>Zir</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>zirs</i> .	<i>Ze</i> likes <i>zerself</i> .
Xe	<i>Xe</i> laughed.	I called <i>xem</i> .	<i>Xyr</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>xyrs</i> .	<i>Xe</i> likes <i>xemself</i> .
Ne	<i>Ne</i> laughed.	I called <i>nem</i> .	<i>Nir</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>nirs</i> .	<i>Ne</i> likes <i>nemself</i> .
Ve	<i>Ve</i> laughed.	I called <i>ver</i> .	<i>Vis</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>vis</i> .	<i>Ve</i> likes <i>verself</i> .
Humanist	<i>Hu</i> laughed.	I called <i>hum</i> .	<i>Hus</i> eyes gleam.	That's <i>hus</i> .	<i>Hu</i> likes <i>humself</i> .

Mx., pronounced “mix”, is the gender neutral title preferred by some people. Use instead of Mr., Ms., etc.
